





- The majority of teachers in our observations are on or finishing lessons 3 or 4!
- Keep up the great work with reviewing strategies every time you teach!
- Make sure to use the software in conjunction with your instruction! The online lessons mirror your teaching so try to keep kids in pace to maximize learning.
- When TAPPing prompts, remember the first P is Purpose and the second P is Parameters. Purpose involves genre words/phrases like "Give your opinion", "convince", "persuade", etc. Parameters involve the structure and form of the writing such as "write an essay" or "write a letter", "write 2 paragraphs", "include three reasons to support", etc.
